Over time, it passed into the hands of prestigious owners such as Henri II Plantagenêt, Richard Cœur de Lion, and Phillippe Auguste, who strengthened the building into a true fortress.

These small fire-baked bread balls are filled with either savory or sweet toppings, according to your taste, sure to please everyone's palate.


